HELP FOR THE HOMELESS AND HOUSING ISSUES

We help people who are homeless or have housing problems to access help.

If you fancy meeting some other Scots, we hold monthly lunches in locations across London and organize occasional trips out. We can also arrange befrienders to visit you at home.



HELP FOR STRUGGLING FAMILIES

If you need help to give your kids a better start in life, we may be able to help with costs towards essential items such as new school uniforms.

We also offer family trips at Christmas and summer time.
